Meeting Minutes for Public Hearing July 8, 2020

Pursuant to Governor Baker's March 12, 2020 Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, G.L. c. 30A, §18, and the Governor's March 15, 2020 Order imposing strict limitations on the number of people that may gather in one place, this meeting of the **Lake Quinsigamond Commission** will be conducted via remote participation to the greatest extent possible. All meetings and hearings listed in the agenda will be done so through remote participation. 1. Called Meeting to Order at 7:02 pm
2. Roll Call of Commissioners
1. **Public Hearing:** Matters regarding Boat Operator and Owner Alberto Cordero and DAMD Auto Body, of Worcester, pursuant to rule 29 and rule 30 (rules are listed below) . Alberto Cordero was not present at this hearing. Request by Shrewsbury Police Department a no trespass order for himself and any vessel he owns. Mr. Cordero was served in hand at N. Quinsigamond Boat ramp on July 4th, 2020 by an officer along with being sent a certified notice in the mail on July 1st, 2020. He received more than 5 violations in a span of 3-4 weeks. The Commission is asking to remove him for 1 year as he is risking the safety of others on the lake.

Mr. Collins asked if Mr. Cordero was present and he was not. There was no one from the public that wished to speak on the matter.

After waiting to see if there were any one from the public that wanted to speak they moved to entertaining a motion starting with Rule 29: Banning Mr. Cordero as an operator for a 1 year period from July 9th, 2020 until July 9th, 2021 motioned by Ken Polito and Second by Mike Paika. All are in favor. Rule 30: Ban both vehicles and any vesicle owned by Mr. Cordero for a 1 year period from July 9th, 2020 until July 9th, 2021 motioned by Ken Polito and Second by Mike Paika. All are in favor.

Rule 29: The Lake Quinsigamond Commission may ban an operator of any vessel from the waters of Lake Quinsigamond for a period of up to one year if the Commission finds after a public hearing that the person operated a vessel in a manner that was negligent or endangered the public.

Rule 30: The Lake Quinsigamond Commission may order the removal of any vessel from the waters of Lake Quinsigamond for a period of up to one year if the Commission finds after a public hearing that the vessel was operated in a manner that was negligent or endangered the public.
