Preschool Storytime: A storytime for 4 and 5 year olds - the older listener. This program will include more involved stories and activities that appeal to and are manageable by the older child. This program will be held in the Children's Program Room. (Note: you must register for each date separately. Registration opens 2 weeks before the date of each program.)

Babies, Books and Bubbles: This program is a free drop-in, however, we do require tokens for admission. Tokens will be available at the Children's Room desk on a first-come, first-served basis starting at 10 am on the day of the program and will be available until they run out (and/or the program has already begun). Every participant must have a token for admission. Enjoy songs, fingerplays and books with the littlest listeners. Babies from birth to 2 are welcome, along with their caregivers. Come for the stories and songs, stay for the bubbles and toys!

Book Beats: Attention Families...Book Beats has a New Format!! The program is a free drop-in, however, we will now require tokens for admission. Tokens will be available at the Children's Room desk on a first-come, first-served basis starting at 9 am on the day of the program and will be available until they run out (and/or the program has already begun). Every participant must have a token for admission. Join Miss Roxanne for this lively music and movement program and storytime, geared to children ages 2-5, but all ages welcome. We'll read - or sing! - a few books, followed by singing and moving along to music, with the help of rhythm sticks, percussion eggs, colorful scarves, and band instruments.

Young Scientist: Young Scientists is a FREE hands-on enrichment program facilitated by STEM Beginnings. Space is limited, registration opens two weeks before the date of each class. The program is presented by the YMCA Family and Community Partnership (YFCP) with STEM Beginnings.
