Online Payment Subscription Contest Guidelines

Purpose

The Shrewsbury Department of Public Works is striving to strengthen our bond with the community. Our goal is to enhance the Town's relevance in the day-to-day lives of our community and engender interest in the next generation of residents. This contest is designed to update our records and encourage residents to use Unipay's, online Bill presentment, for billing purposes.

Participation & Guidelines

- The contest is open to all Shrewsbury residents
- Entrants must have an active Shrewsbury Utility Account (any combination of Water, Sewer, Stormwater)
- One entry per household
- Town Employees **are not** eligible for award.
- Residents who are already enrolled will qualify and be entered into the lottery

Submission

Participants must complete the following three steps to be eligible for the lottery:

1. Update/Confirm utility contact information by either calling the office at 508-841-8506 or filling out the online form (in process)
2. Enroll in Unipay Save paper and time! Enroll online [here](#)
3. Sign up for SeeClickfix. Our SeeClickfix platform is used to help resolve many issues you may have in town from reporting a snow issue to missed trash pickups. Enroll online [here](#).

Submission Deadline

The contest closes at **4:30 PM (EST) September 30, 2021**. Late submissions will not be considered.

Prizes

All contestants will be entered into a lottery for ten (10) prizes. Two (2) grand Prize winners will receive 10 rolls of larger PAY-T bags and 10 rolls of small PAY-T bags. Total value of \$167.50.

Runner-ups will awarded as follows:

Two (2) winners	6 Rolls Large PAY-T Bags, 6 Rolls Small PAY-T Bags

Two (2) winners	2Rolls Large PAY-T Bags, 2 Rolls Small PAY-T Bags
