Shrewsbury Recycling Information 2016 – 2017

For Residents participating in the Municipal Rubbish & Recycling Collection Program



Did you know...? Massachusetts laws mandate the recycling of:

- Paper and Cardboard
- Bottles and Cans
- Leaves and Yard Waste
- Car Batteries
- TVs and Computers
- Appliances and Electronics

Be sure to keep these items out of your trash by recycling them.

Recycling Schedule:

Recycling is collected every other week on your regular rubbish collection day. It is important to have your bin at the curb by **7:00 A.M.**, as routes and drivers are subject to change without notice. In the winter months, the bin needs to be free of snow & ice and clearly visible to the collection crew.

The town is divided into two routes indicated by color (**BLUE** or **GREEN**).

Holiday Schedule:

When a scheduled collection falls on a holiday, that day's collection and all remaining collections for the week will be delayed by one day.

Friday's collection will be on Saturday. Holidays are noted in **yellow** on the calendar.

The Town observes: New Year's Day, Martin Luther King, Jr. Birthday, Washington's Birthday, Patriots Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas Day.

Recycling Bin Options:

- Residents may purchase a 22 gallon recycling bin at the Health Department located within the Town Hall. The cost is \$11.00* (*price is subject to change). Cash or Check made payable to: Town of Shrewsbury
 - Note: Residents *are not* required to purchase a bin from the Town
- Residents may purchase on their own, up to a 32 gallon (maximum size) barrel from any hardware store. The Health Department can give a RECYCLE decal (free-of-charge) to adhere to the outside of the barrel (limit of two decals per family).
- Residents may use something as simple as a laundry basket as long as it's labeled RECYCLE. Please visit the Health Department for a RECYCLE decal (limit of two decals per family).
- There is no limit to the number of bins you can place at the curb.

ITEMS YOU CAN RECYCLE:

- Plastics, cans, bottles, cartons can be commingled in the same bin (please rinse out beforehand).
- Paper can also be placed in the same bin as long as it's in own paper bag and set on top of the bin.
- Shrewsbury is not a single-stream community (i.e. paper must be separated from bottles, jars, and cans).

NOT RECYCLABLE: Styrofoam®, Diapers, Depends, Garden Hoses, Flower Pots, Hazardous Waste, Plastic Bags
